







OVERVIEW - GRAHAME PARK

CLEAR, HOLD, BUILD





The Grahame Park Estate is a large housing estate in Barnet, primarily located within the NW9 postal district. It was built by the Greater London Council in the 1960s, originally comprising 1,777 homes. It has historically suffered from socioeconomic deprivation, high crime and unemployment rates.

Drug supply and trafficking has been identified by frontline policing teams and specialist crime as the primary crime type in the area, driving the majority of organised criminality and violence.

Lethal Barrel Weapon Discharges


Data from the last 12 months shows that the Grahame Park Estate is the biggest hot spot within Barnet for lethal barrel weapon discharges.

Fifteen such discharges have occurred since December 2022, resulting in two severe injuries and no fatalities.

Anti-Social Behaviour

A heat map of anti-social behaviour across Barnet in the last 12 months indicates that the Grahame Park Estate has one of the highest rates of anti-social behaviour in the borough.

Hot spots also appear around the Grahame Park Estate for robberies, knife crime, and drug trafficking.

































Co-ordination group priorities

The priorities set out by the partners and residents in 2023 were:

- Reduced levels of crime
- To feel safe walking around the Estate
- For young people to be able to use facilities with their friends without fear of crime
- Make reporting crime easier and more importantly that there is faith that action will be taken when crime is reported
- Build a stronger relationship between residents and partners where they are viewed as part of the community



Clear Hold Build/Operation Dakota

- Over the course of the 6 month period Dakota produced over 300 arrests for 528 offences. This included 5 for murder, 23 for burglary, 5 for robbery and 3 for kidnap. The specific effort to target drug dealers and the drugs market led to 60 individuals arrested for Class A supply or PWITS. Further to this, 8 firearms were seized, 52 knives/weapons and 28 closure orders in some ground breaking work on a national scale.
- There have been no further lethal barrelled discharges in this area since May 23
- Operation Woodson ASB 35% reduction
