What the law says

The Equality Act 2010 - Section 168 / 170

"The driver must -

- (a) carry the disabled person's dog ...
- (b) not make any additional charge for doing so"



but still...



3 in 4 assistance dog owners have been refused access

What can you do?

- Require Disability Equality Training
- Implement taxi and PHV policy assistance dogs
- Make exemption certificates tactile

Disability Equality Training

- Locally: a third of licencing authorities currently require disability equality training
- Nationally:
 - Transport Select Committee
 - Law Commission
 - HoL Equality Act Committee
 - Andrew Gwynne MP's Private Member Bill

Tactile Exemption Certificates

- Braille not necessary a raised or embossed "E" is sufficient
- Guide Dogs are currently working on these.
