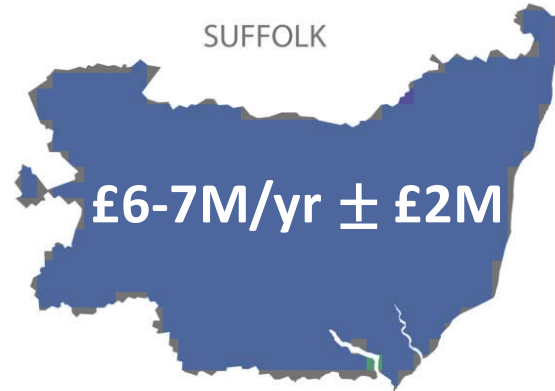
# Massive £ uncertainty at a difficult time

Food collection (Simpler Recycling)	c. £0.5-0.75 Bn	31/3/2026	No
Material Facility Regs (sampling)	Est £10s M	01/10/2024	No
POPs in Soft Furnishings	Est £100 M	31/12/2024	No
Emissions Trading Scheme for EfW	c. £1 Bn	2028	No

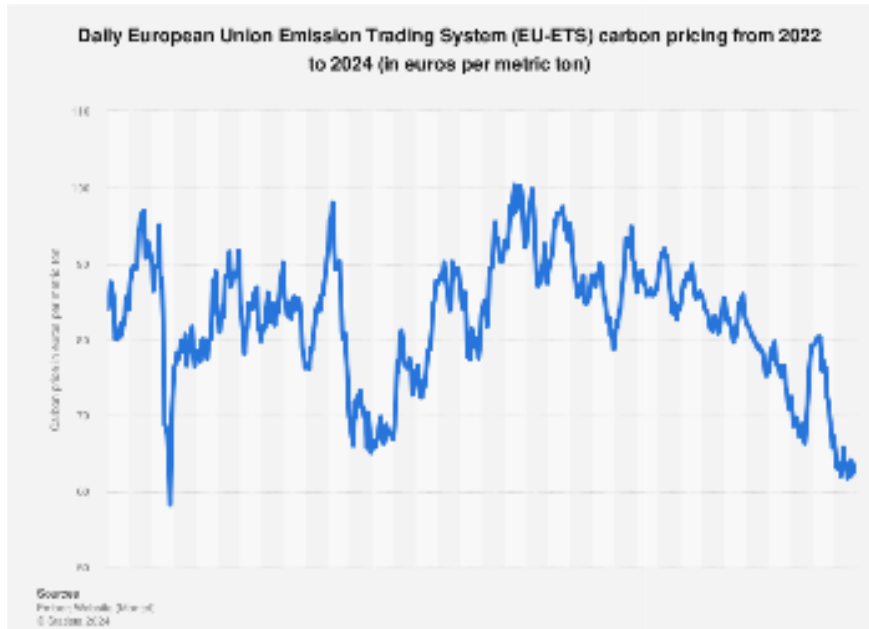
# Can our council(s) cope with ETS?

# Key messages

1. LAs are the delivery mechanism for most waste reforms
2. Council finances under immense pressure, and impact of waste reforms is £ huge
3. Continued funding uncertainty is preventing council decisions and investment
4. Our budgets can't cope with ETS market price volatility
5. Pursue 'polluter pays principle' to effectively link waste policy, financial levers and carbon impacts
